Stacey Doré is Chief Legal Officer at Sempra. Sempra utility and infrastructure companies are on a collective mission to build North America's premier energy infrastructure company.

Prior to her current role, Ms. Doré was CEO of Sharyland Utilities, L.L.C., an electric utility that owns rate-regulated transmission infrastructure in Texas. She also served as President of Hunt Utility Services, LLC (HUS), which manages Sharyland. HUS is a wholly owned subsidiary of Hunt Consolidated, Inc., managed by the Ray L. Hunt family. As CEO, Ms. Doré set the strategic direction for Sharyland and led a seasoned team of professionals in operating the company's electric transmission assets safely, reliably and compliantly.

Previously, Ms. Doré was senior vice president and general counsel of publicly-traded InfraREIT, Inc. Before that, Ms. Doré spent eight years at Energy Future Holdings Corp. (EFH), most recently serving as executive vice president, general counsel and chief restructuring officer. At EFH, Ms. Doré led a team of more than 50 professionals and managed all aspects of the largest Chapter 11 restructuring ever filed in Delaware as the company worked out a plan to restructure more than \$40 billion in debt.

Before joining EFH, Ms. Doré was a trial lawyer with Vinson & Elkins LLP, where she engaged in a business litigation practice for 11 years.

Ms. Doré is an active member of the United Way Women of Tocqueville and received the prestigious Advocate Award from United Way. She also serves as a trustee of Trinity Christian Academy, where her sons attend school. She is a member of the Dallas Assembly, a 2010 graduate of Leadership Dallas and a 2011 graduate of the General Counsel Forum's Institute for Leadership in the Law. She previously served on the national and local boards of Girls Inc. and as a board member of the Trinity River Local Government Corporation.

Ms. Doré was named by the Dallas Business Journal as one of the Top 25 Women in Business in 2012. In 2015, the EFH Legal Team was named Legal Department of the Year by Texas Lawyer; in 2016, Ms. Doré was named Outstanding Corporate Counsel by the Dallas Women Lawyers Association; and in 2018, Ms. Doré was named Outstanding General Counsel of the Year by the Association of Corporate Counsel DFW Chapter. Ms. Doré received her juris doctorate from Harvard Law School in 1997.
